Boarding Checklist

Please refer to this checklist to make sure you and your dog(s) are properly prepared for their stay!

FOOD

- Happy Paws Pet Resort suggests you bring enough food for the duration of your stay. It is a good idea to pack slightly more just in case! Keeping your dog(s) on a consistent dietary regimen similar to what they experience at home is a good way to keep them comfortable and healthy. *If you wish for Happy Paws Pet Resort to provide food or if you run out, we will supply great, high quality food and charge a fee.*
- Please store your food in an **AIRTIGHT PLASTIC CONTAINER** or **ZIPLOCK BAG** (no glass or ceramic).
- Please be sure to label your food containers with a permanent marker.
- If the feeding regimen requires more than 2 ingredients or special handling (lots of mixing, RAW food, lots of refrigerated ingredients, etc) then there will be an additional **“Food Handling Charge”** added to your bill.

TOYS/BEDDING

- Happy Paws Pet Resort supplies raised beds that allow the dogs to sleep off of the ground. These beds are quick drying and promote fresh airflow.
- If you would like to bring (1) blanket OR (1) article of additional bedding, it must be properly labeled and be **MACHINE WASHABLE**. If the bedding isn't machine washable, we unfortunately will not be able to give your dog access to it during their stay.
- Each dog is allowed to bring up to (2) toys during their stay.

VACCINATIONS / MEDICATIONS

- Please refer to the Happy Paws Pet Resort contract to review vaccination requirements as well as medication requirements.
- All dogs must be properly vaccinated with medical records available prior to their checkin.
- All medications, supplements, etc must be in their original packaging with clear instructions provided.
- All pets are required to have flea and tick treatments to ensure the cleanliness of our facility.
- Capstar, an instant flea medication may be administered if deemed necessary by the Happy Paws Pet Resort staff, and will be administered at the owner's expense (\$18). In certain cases, a bath may be deemed necessary as well and will also be added to the bill.

SPECIAL HANDLING

- If your dog exhibits aggressive behavior, or any behavior that prohibits the Happy Paws Pet Resort staff from properly executing their job description, or puts any of our staff in danger, or prohibits our staff from providing the requested services, the services provided may be amended. If the dog presents challenging handling requirements to the Happy Paws Pet Resort staff, a special handling fee may be added to the bill (\$10/day).
